

## Coach's Code of Conduct

- Coaches should read and discuss all the Codes of Conduct with all members of your coaching staff and your team manager. It is a condition of Club membership that all coaches follow the Coach's Code of Conduct at all times.
- I will remember that players and parents need a coach that they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- I will not ridicule or yell at players (of our team or the opposition) or officials for making mistakes or for performing poorly.
- I will help each athlete realize his or her full potential.
- I will teach players to act fairly and respect the rules, referees and our opponents.
- I understand that I am responsible for ensuring that substitute players, bench personnel and my team's spectators do not interfere with or disturb the match.
- I will place school and family relationships above all other activities.
- I will be on time and prepared for games and practices.
- I will inform parents of any injuries that their child may have incurred.
- I will dress appropriately at all games and practices so that I present a professional image.
- I will avoid the use of tobacco and refrain from being under the influence of alcohol during practices or contests.
- I will not contact a player under the age of 18 by phone, text, email etc. without permission from their parent/guardian in writing.
- I will provide the convenor with a list of my assistant coaches and their contact information.
- I will ensure that no one without a police check will be left alone with any of my players during practice or game times.
- I will contact the Convenor in writing with any complaints I have.
